Common Name	Scientific Name	Conservation Status	Beddington Farmlands Status
Small Skipper	<i>Thymelicus sylvestris</i>		Uncertainty due to similarity of Essex Skipper. June to August.
Essex Skipper	<i>Thymelicus lineola</i>		Abundant in grasslands. July to August.
Large Skipper	<i>Ochlodes sylvanus</i>		Regular along wooded paths and borders and grasslands. June to August.
Swallowtail	<i>Papilio machaon</i>		Vagrant. One record.
Clouded Yellow	<i>Colias croceus</i>		Irregular/ near annual migrant in grasslands. Mainly July to October.
Brimstone	<i>Gonepteryx rhamni</i>		Regular along wooded edges through spring to autumn. Mainly in Spring.
Large White	<i>Pieris brassicae</i>		Common in variety of habitats. April to September.
Small White	<i>Pieris rapae</i>		Common, mainly along wooded edges and paths. April to September.
Green-veined White	<i>Peiris napi</i>		Common, mainly along wooded edges and paths. April to September.
Orange-tip	<i>Anthocharis cardamines</i>		Regular along wooded paths. Mainly April to June.
Green Hairstreak	<i>Callophrys rubi</i>		Rare. May to June.
Brown Hairstreak	<i>Thecla betulae</i>	BAP species	Vagrant. July to September.
Purple Hairstreak	<i>Neozephyrus quercus</i>		Present most years along Oak borders. July to August.
White-letter Hairstreak	<i>Satyrrium w-album</i>	BAP species	Small population on Irrigation Bridge in Elm trees. June to July.
Small Copper	<i>Lycaena phlaeas</i>		Irregular. April to September.
Brown Argus	<i>Aricia agestis</i>		Uncommon. April to September.
Common Blue	<i>Polyommatus icarus</i>		Common in grasslands. Mainly late May to September.
Chalkhill Blue	<i>Polyommatus coridon</i>		Vagrant. One record August 6 th 2013
Holly Blue	<i>Celastrina argiolus</i>		Common along wood edges and paths. April to September. Less in mid-summer.
Camberwell Beauty	<i>Nymphalis antiopa</i>		Vagrant. One record.
Red Admiral	<i>Vanessa atalanta</i>		Common. Migrant. February to October. Hibernates on site.
Painted Lady	<i>Vanessa cardui</i>		Irregular migrant. Some years major influxes. April to October.
Small Tortoiseshell	<i>Aglais urticae</i>		Common in variety of habitats. Spring to autumn.
Peacock	<i>Inachis io</i>		Regular in variety of habitats. Spring to

			autumn. Hibernates on site.	
Comma	<i>Polygonia c-album</i>		Regular along wooded paths and borders. Spring to autumn.	
Speckled Wood	<i>Pararge aegeria</i>		Regular along wooded paths and borders. March to October.	
Marbled White	<i>Melanargia galathea</i>		Regular in grasslands. June to August.	
Gatekeeper	<i>Pyronia tithonus</i>		Common mainly along wooded paths. July to August.	
Meadow Brown	<i>Maniola jurtina</i>		Abundant in grasslands. June to September.	
Ringlet	<i>Aphantopus hyperanthus</i>		Regular. Mainly along wooded paths/grassland transition. June to August.	
Small Heath	<i>Coenonympha pamphilus</i>		Irregular in grasslands. April to September.
